2. Foot problems/issues	2	1	2	Yes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure appropriate footwear used for street patrols • Take appropriate measures during break if first aid required...blisters! • Have spare socks and footwear at base.

Dealing with aggressive individuals	4	1	4	Yes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Always remain within areas covered by CCTV cameras • Follow instructions given at training. • Team to provide support • Call for CCTV coverage if required. • Call for Police assistance • Record incident in report form.

Dealing with fights.	3	2	5	Yes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Always remain within areas covered by CCTV cameras • Follow protocols as instructed at training • Do not intervene in fight • Team to provide support • Call for CCTV coverage if required • Call for Police assistance • Record incident in report form.

Personal injury due to attack	2	3/4	6/8	Yes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Always remain within areas covered by CCTV cameras • Call for ambulance • Call Police • Inform coordinator who will contact named person on emergency contacts list • Team member to accompany injured individual to A&E • Team leader returns team to base. • Coordinator to deal with media. • Record incident in report form.
6. Personal injury from broken glass	3	3	9	Yes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use dustpan and brush provided • If picking up large pieces of glass always use appropriate gloves • Appropriate First Aid treatment given by team or staff in safe Zone.

Road Crossing	2	4	8	Yes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use marked crossings when available. • Always observe red and green lights at peak times when crossing • On other occasions always look, listen before crossing • Do not cross roads to issue flipflops or for other reasons without adequate attention to personal safety.
10. Illness while on duty	2	3	6	Yes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Team leader to assess situation..home/hospital • Inform coordinator who will contact named person on emergency contacts list
